The Innovative Development Fund for Innovative Solutions.

The Innovative Solutions Support assists eligible services to fund innovative and flexible solutions to inclusion, where a barrier has been identified and it cannot be addressed by the support provided by its Inclusion Agency (IA), or through other IDF funding streams. Eligible services can work collaboratively with their IA to identify barriers and propose innovative solutions to inclusion to meet the specific needs of the service.

Centres may be eligible for the Innovative Solutions Support Funding (Inclusion Fund Manager) offered from KU. An application for the IDF Innovative Solutions Support may relate to a particular care environment where the inclusion barrier is presented, or in the context of the whole service.

We have also developed Engine Rooms with schools to support the development of emotion regulation, sensory processing, fine and gross motor skills, coordination, balance, and executive functioning skills.



Executive Functioning Skills develop between the ages of 3-5yrs.

There are windows of opportunity when a child's brain is open for new learning and will soak up information faster. This window is between 3-5 years of age. Becoming a successful adult can depend on the experiences gained during these years.

Developing cognitive skills that build Executive Functions at this time is important. This can be achieved through fun activities that promote:

- Focus
- Planning
- Cognitive Flexibility
- Working Memory
- Time Management
- Emotion Regulation
